



2023 Jamboree River Rafting Instructions

Please read the Adventure Guide for complete details.

- Each rafter must have a wrist band labeled with the assigned rafting day and time. This is the ticket to admittance. These “tickets” for each paid rafter were provided in the leader’s packet.
- **All rafting participants must bring a completed and signed waiver to rafting check-in at your assigned day and time.** Each rafter should hold their own waiver when in the registration queue.
- Complete the attached completed roster with the name of each participant and bring it to rafting check-in at your assigned rafting time.
- It is the contingent leader’s responsibility to ensure that all rafting participants have passed the BSA Swim Classification Test.
- Rafting is a prescheduled event. Contingents must raft on their assigned day and time.
- Arrive 10 to 15 minutes prior to your scheduled time.
- Contingents rafting at the 11:00 am time slot should bring their lunch or eat prior to arrival.
- One adult is required to accompany the rafters until the check-in process is complete.
- Rafting wrist banding – Rafters will be bused to and from the New River with Professional Outfitters. Each bus will be assigned a colored wrist band. (THIS IS A DIFFERENT WRIST BAND THAN THE “TICKET” BAND IN THE LEADERS’ PACKET.) All rafters are assigned a color group for the entire trip. Participants **MUST** remain with their assigned color group for travel to/from the river and during rafting.
- **Contingents may be split between buses (color groups) and rafts.**
- Fill water bottles prior to entering the check-in line. Water is available at the rafting site.
- Only when entire group is present, enter the check-in line (look for signage.)
- Rafters must remain quiet during the safety video, so everyone can hear.
- **Gear storage** – Each contingent will be provided bin(s) to store their personal gear while rafting. (*The Jamboree and Rafting IST are not responsible for items left in the gear storage area.*)
- **Return to the Summit:** Board the bus to return with your color group. The bus you arrived in at the river will not necessarily be the bus that will return you to the Jamboree.
- **THE BUSES ARE NOT PERMITTED TO DROP ANYONE OFF AT THEIR CAMPSITE OR OTHER JAMBOREE LOCATIONS. ALL RAFTERS MUST RETURN TO THE RAFTING SITE TO VERIFY THEIR RETURN TO THE SUMMIT.**

Required Gear:

- Any medications (i.e. epinephrine pens, inhalers, etc.) Anyone requiring these items, who do not have them on their person, will **NOT** be permitted to raft.
- Clothing suitable for swimming
- **Closed-toed shoes**
- Sunscreen
- Camera (optional) – must be waterproof. **Participants are NOT permitted to hold a camera in their hands while rafting.**
